

FISH WINNIPEG SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM



About Fish Winnipeg

Fish Winnipeg, in support of Winnipeg's Urban Angling Partnership, is a non-profit organization that raises monies to support youth angling programs in the City of Winnipeg. The program introduces youth to recreational fishing opportunities while promoting angling as a healthy, self-esteem building outdoor leisure activity for our youth. Since its inception, Fish Winnipeg has raised over \$350,000 and provided in

excess of 8,000 youth with an opportunity to participate in recreational fishing within Winnipeg city limits. For many of these youth, this was their first fishing experience and hopefully provided a good foundation to continue participating in this activity into the future.



Scholarship Program

The Fish Winnipeg Scholarship Program (FWSP) administrated by Fish Futures Inc. was established in 2012 to support Winnipeg's youth who wish to continue pursuing a post-secondary education in natural resources, with an emphasis on fisheries. The scholarships are awarded to graduating high school students entering a post-secondary institution and to students already enrolled in a recognized academic facility.

The program's emphasis is placed on youth who have participated in the Fish Winnipeg program and wish to

enhance their understanding of Manitoba's fisheries resource. Applicants must demonstrate how the scholarship will benefit their current studies and what their aspirations are for the future.

A total of two scholarships will offered each calendar year pending available funds. Each scholarship will be valued at **\$1,000.00** CDN.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Candidates must be:

- a resident of Manitoba; and
- be attending or planning to enrol in a degree or diploma program at a Manitoba recognized post-secondary institute.

NOTIFICATION

Applicants will be notified by the end of April by the scholarship administrator regarding the selection results.

Successful applicants will receive a grant scholarship agreement with further details and conditions.



APPLICATION DEADLINE

All applications must be received no later than March 31 to be eligible for the fall and/or winter semesters.
